A361 Night Closures & Traffic Lights – Feb/Mar 2024

TRAFFIC LIGHTS - From 20.02.24 to 21.03.24 - During daytime hours two sets traffic lights will be in place between 6am & 8pm between North Aller roundabout & Landkey Roundabout.

NIGHT CLOSURES - From 19.02.24 to 22.03.24 - The A361 between North Aller roundabout & Landkey Roundabout will be closed at night from 8pm to 6am between North Aller Roundabout & Landkey Roundabout.

During this period delays are expected on the A361 & drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes & avoid busy times.

FAQ:

Q. Why are the traffic lights being implemented?

A. Griffiths needs to excavate the road in a number of areas to waterproof major structures beneath the road. During this operation only half the road can be kept open, & traffic managed with signals. In order to maximise the use of these traffic restrictions Griffiths will be carrying out drainage works, safety barriers & resurfacing.

Q. Will there be delays?

A. Delays will be expected, particularly at peak times. The traffic lights will be monitored at all times. Griffiths will naturally prioritise these works & remove this traffic restriction as quickly as possible

Q. What about Emergency Services?

A. We are working closely with the Emergency Services & have a 24hr Traffic Safety Officer on site to assist with their travels

Q. What about Wide / Abnormal loads?

A. Wide / Abnormal loads will be escorted through the work areas & if very large traffic diverted to facilitate.

Q. What is the diversion route for the night closures?

A. When the A361 is closed between Landkey & North Aller Roundabout at night the diversion route will be via Blakes Hill Road past Swimbridge & Filleigh. See Diversion map on page 2 of this Bulletin.

Work is specialised, weather dependant & intricate but every effort will be made to complete it as quickly as possible to re-open the road to two way flow.

We will continue to update you via separate bulletins with more detail of the works.

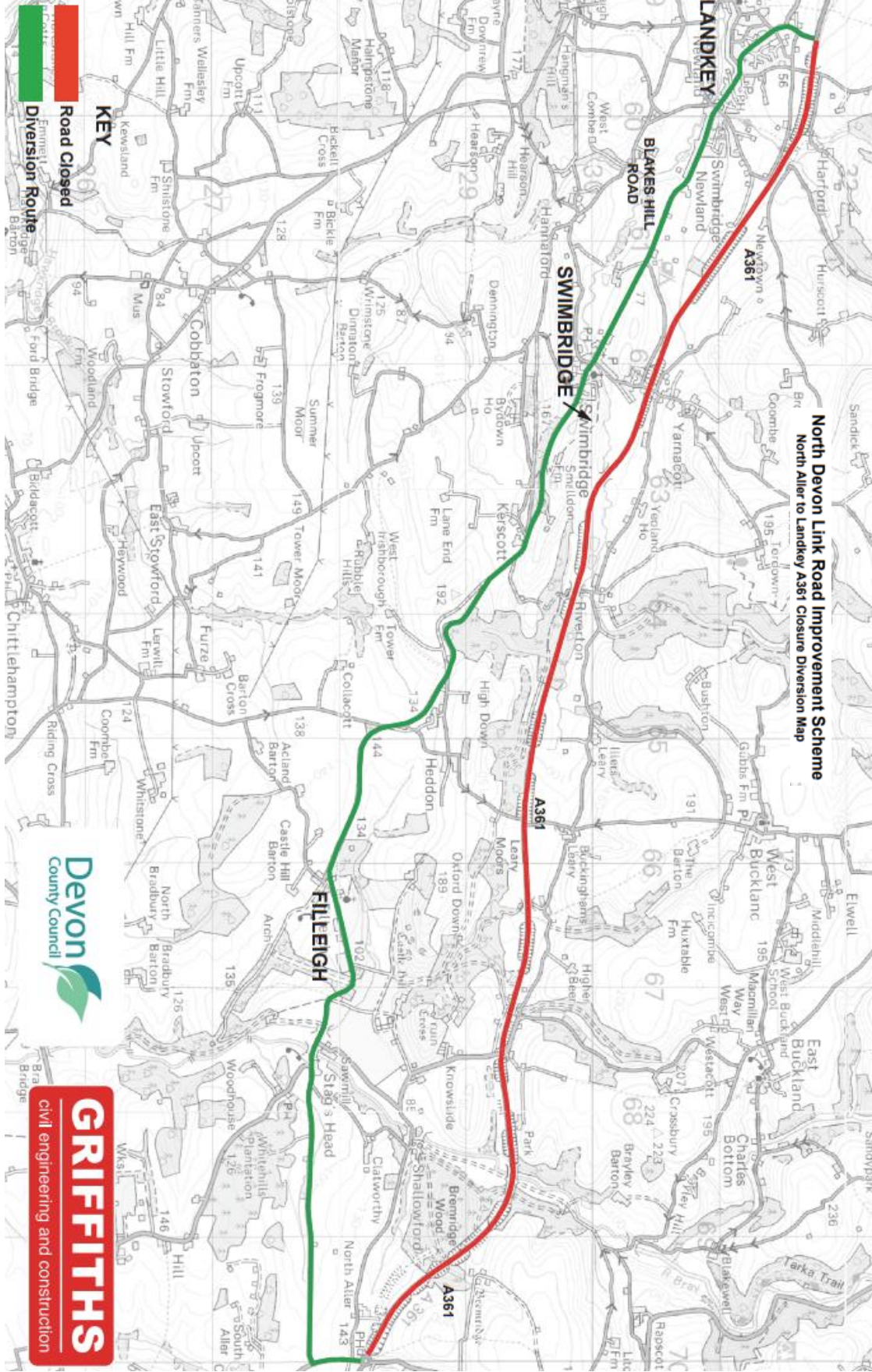
